We look forward to hearing which charity they will donate their £50 to.

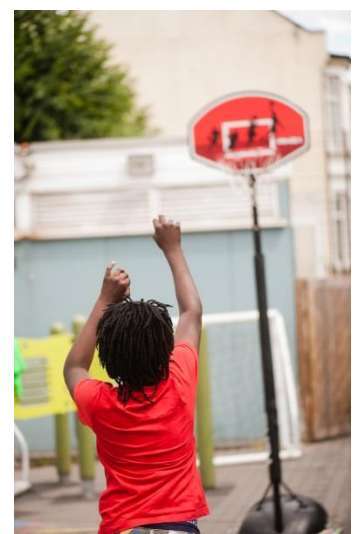
End of Term Picnic Party !
