This week, we will be thinking about 'pupil voice' in our phase assemblies.

Ramadan

We are aware that for Muslim families this week marks the beginning of Ramadan. In school we will be recognising and building upon the essence and spirit of Ramadan by considering some of the values of Ramadan and encouraging all children to think about showing respect for others, kindness, forgiveness and having empathy with those who are less fortunate.

In line with the guidance from the Muslim Council of Britain and advice from SACRE (Newham's Standing Advisory Council on Religious Education) we ask that any children below the age of puberty do not fast during school time. For those children who have reached the age of puberty, and who do wish to fast, we ask that you write to the Head Teacher.

Unfortunately we are unable to provide an inside area at lunchtime for the children to stay out of the heat therefore if we have received a letter to say that your child will be fasting, we recommend that your child goes home at lunchtime in order that appropriate provision can be made.




Safety in the Sun
