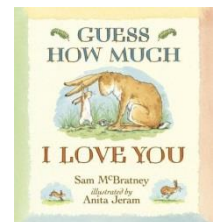

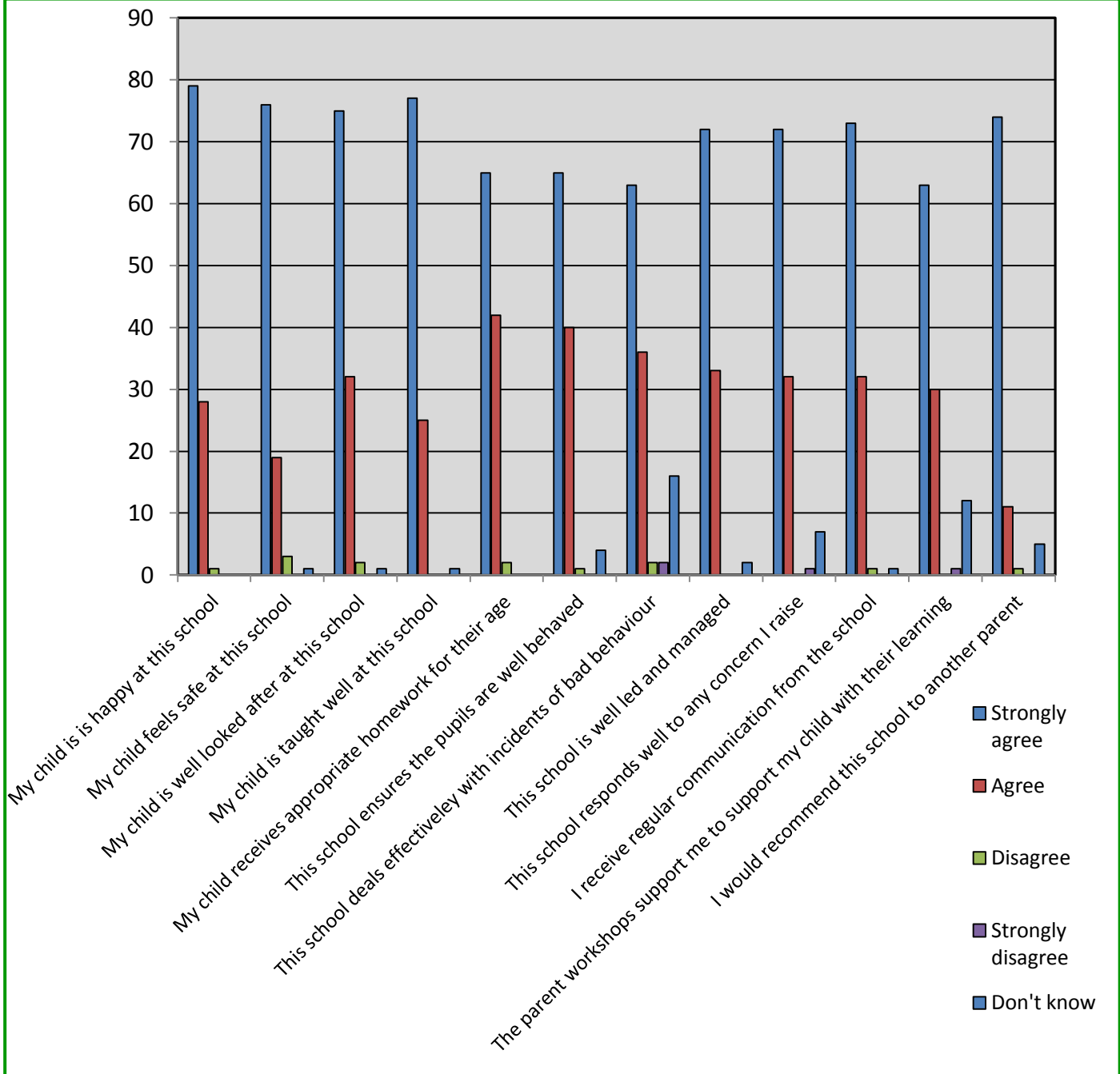

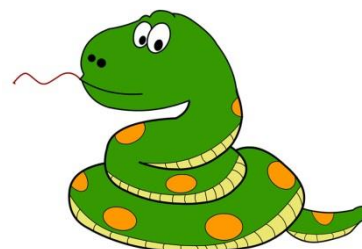
Learning Power

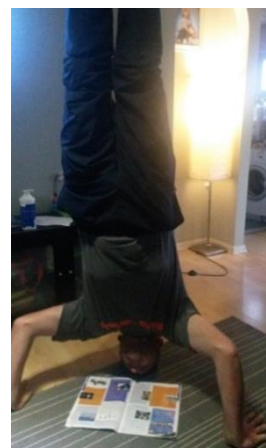
