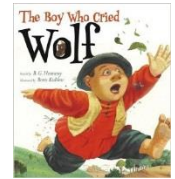
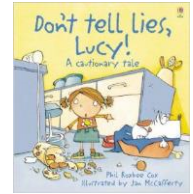
The children will be reading the story 'Don't Tell Lies, Lucy'.
