- > Exploring all areas of mathematics.




Number

- ➤ Days of the week
- ➤ Months of the year
- > Length (Taller, shorter, longer, shorter)
- > Capacity (Full, half full, empty)
- > Weight (Heavier, heavy, lighter, light)
- > Vocabulary
