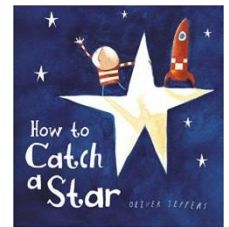

We are increasingly hearing that primary age children are using the App **Musical.ly**. The danger of this App is that videos are uploaded to the internet where other users can then communicate with your child. It has been reported that this app is being misused by adults attempting to make inappropriate contact with children. There has been an incident whereby an 8 year old girl was receiving highly inappropriate messages from someone claiming to be an 8 year old boy.

We urge you to closely monitor your child's online activity, including their use of apps such as this.

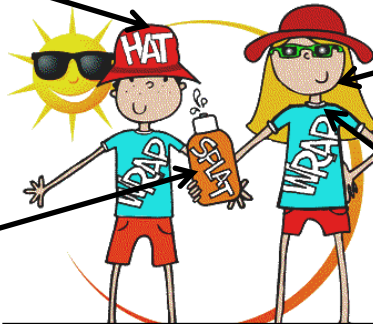
## Safety in the Sun



Wear a hat to cover the face, ears and neck.

Apply sunscreen before your child comes to school.

Bring a labelled bottle of sunscreen into school for your child to apply more before they go out to play.



Children are allowed to wear UV protective sunglasses.

Wear a top that covers your shoulders.

Wear suitable shoes.

Please ensure your child wears suitable shoes to school. In the interests of safety, children should not wear open toe shoes or sandals to school.
