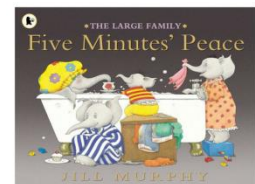

The children will be reading the story 'Five Minutes' Peace'.

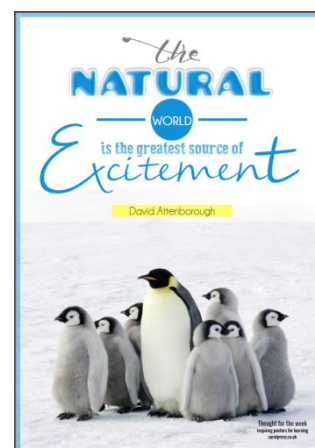
