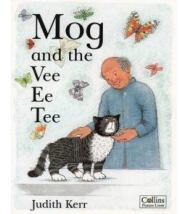

- be tolerant.

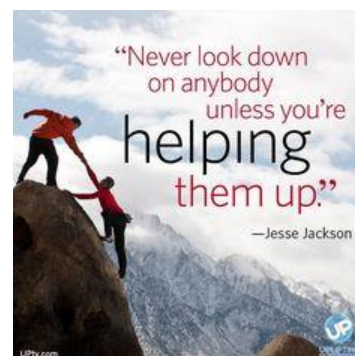

Forest School

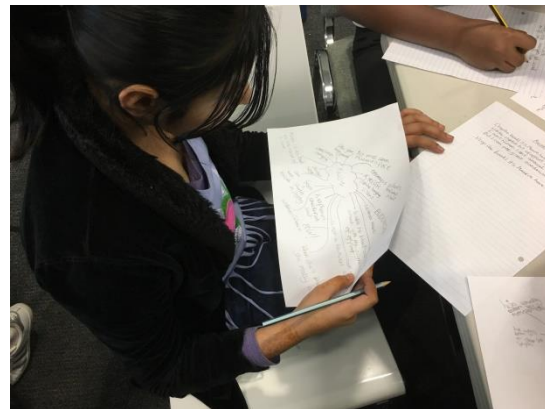

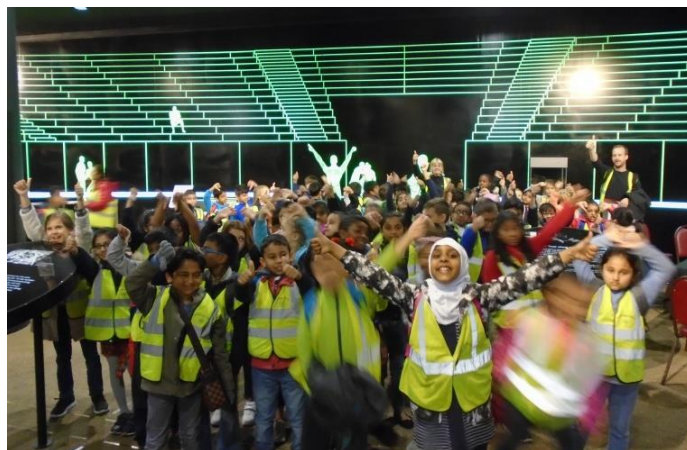

Year 4 explored Roman London last week. Firstly, we visited the London Guildhall Art Gallery where we witnessed the remains of an actual Roman amphitheatre – the site of many a gladiatorial battle. We then moved on to the nearby Museum of London where we experienced how London changed through the Roman era. It was an interesting start to our topic on the Romans.
