Forest School Volunteers

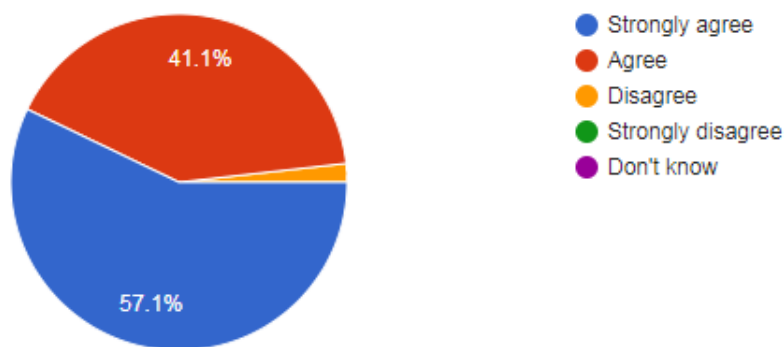
