We were incredibly proud to hear about another one of our children demonstrating how much they care by giving up their own time for others.

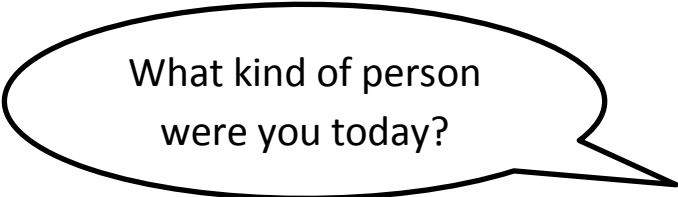
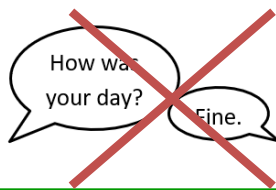

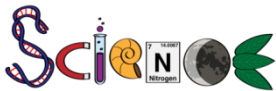
