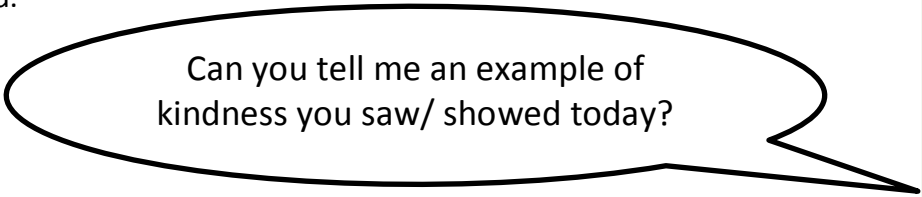
### Lego Donations Please
