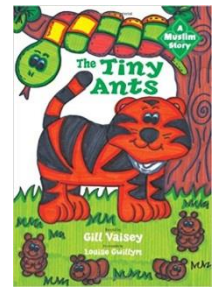
Key Stage 1: **helping**
