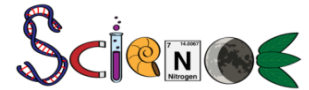

Weekly Science Fact



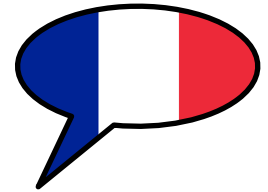
This week's science fact to ponder and discuss is.....
