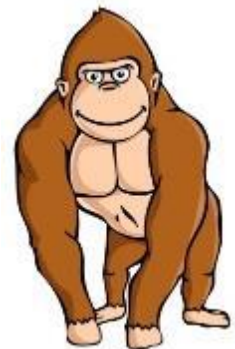
We will be discussing the Buddhist festival Wesak.

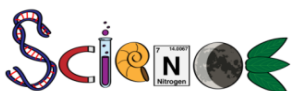

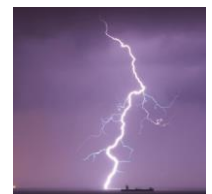

This week's science fact to ponder and discuss is.....

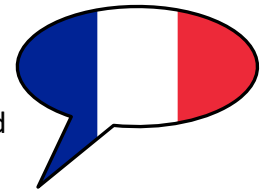


The sound of thunder is produced by rapidly heated air surrounding lightning which expands faster than the speed of sound.
