Clothes bank - Park's clothes bank will be running on Friday 9th February 2.30-3.30 from the front office.


Half term holiday - just a reminder that the last day of school will be Friday 9th February. We will return from the half term holiday on Monday 19th February.



As children, we have opportunities to vote for those we want to represent us such as school council members, sports, arts and eco committees.








Every child with a disability should enjoy the best possible life in society. Governments should remove all obstacles for children with disabilities to become independent and to participate actively in the community.
